The Rio is located in the heart of downtown Greeley, just a short walk from shops, the Union Colony Civic Center and the Greeley History Museum. The restaurant serves an array of flavorful Mexican specialties including fajitas, enchiladas and, of course, the infamous Rio Grande Margarita. The menu offers delicious options for lunch or a light snack.

The Greeley History Museum

Listed on both the Colorado and National Register of Historic Places, the Greeley History Museum is located in the former *Greeley Tribune* office building. Explore Greeley's rich history through mini-exhibits and the temporary exhibits that change about every six months. After you've explored, pick up a souvenir or book in the Museum store.

Directions

- Denver to The Rio: Head North on US-85 BUS N, left at Ninth Street. The Rio is on the right. Continue to Eighth Street and turn right for the Museum.
- Coming from the North? Take US-85 BUS S/N Eighth Avenue (signs for 0 St. E/Greeley/BUS District). Turn right at Ninth Street for The Rio. Turn left at Eighth Street for the Museum. **Free parking is available at the Museum and The Rio.**
